Recently on our way to visit family in Kentucky, we stopped at the Bulleit Bourbon Experience in KY. From the moment we were greeted by Perry at the guard shack (who had been employed there for 48 years) we knew this had the potential to be a great tour and we were not disappointed. Bulleit is one of the locations listed on the Bourbon Trail, so we had assumed that this would be an actual distillery, and although it turned out not to be so, we had the most wonderful tour guide, Sylvia. Sylvia told us stories about the area called Shively (or "Lively Shively" as she called it) and all of its history as well as the history of other distilleries in the area.
